Swim School Levels	Swim Level Descriptions	Class Times
<u>Starfish</u> <i>Parent and Child</i>	<u>Designed for children 12 months-3 yrs old who have never been exposed to swimming.</u> The goal is to familiarize children with water and increase comfort.	5:00pm-5:30pm 5:30pm-6:00pm
<u>Seahorse</u> <i>Preschool class</i>	<u>Designed for children 3-5 yrs old.</u> Introduction to water skills: for children to feel comfortable in the water and safely enjoy it.	5:00pm-5:30pm 5:30pm-6:00pm 6:00pm-6:30pm
<u>Clownfish</u> <i>Beginner class</i>	<u>Fundamentals of water skills</u> (Ages 5-7 yrs old): Children will learn basic swimming skills and safely become independent.	5:00pm-5:30pm 5:30pm-6:00pm 6:00pm-6:30pm
<u>Flounder</u> <i>Intermediate class</i>	<u>Stroke Development</u> (Ages 6-8 yrs old): Additional guided practice will help swimmers improve their strokes and grow in independence.	5:00pm-5:30pm 5:30pm-6:00pm 6:00pm-6:30pm
<u>Marlins</u> <i>Intermediate class</i>	<u>Stroke Improvement</u> (Ages 7-10 yrs old): Swimmers will gain confidence during the lessons, improve stroke technique, and gain additional aquatic skills.	5:30pm-6:00pm 6:00pm-6:30pm
